Unfortunately, due to some past experiences with unsportsmanlike behaviours we now need to have some guidelines for sportsmanship and conduct.

1. Each contestant and family will be held to a strict code of conduct.

Please be gracious to those you meet.

2. Be nice to everyone all of the time, to the people and to the supporters, and especially to your friend's new and old.

3. Disruptive behavior before, during, and after the pageant will not be tolerated and will result in the disqualification of your child and you (and your family) will be asked to leave the premises.

4. **ANY PERSON** that is observed annoying, tormentive, or harassing contestants or parents will be disqualified and asked to leave the premises.

5. Parents- you have a responsibility to your child to show unwavering support and positive reinforcement for your child's performance and effort. Be a good role model and refrain from negativity. They need to see you smiling and happy with how they did.

6. **JUDGES ARE NOT TO BE APPROACHED BEFORE DURING OR AFTER THE PAGEANT.**

7. If you have a complaint or grievance, it needs to be brought to the pageant chairperson, Nadine no later than 8:00pm on the Friday following the pageant. Suggestions and comments are always welcome.

8. **NO REFUND TO BE PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES ONCE ENTERED.**

9. **NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 4TH, 2019.**
